



## Music Ministry Expectations

### **Vision**

We exist to worship God with everything we do. As a music team our goal is to lead people in worship of God through Christ-centered, God-exalting and Spirit-led songs.

### **Expectations**

Because those on the music team are in a very visible leadership position, while modeling the Christian life, the following are among the things expected of you on a regular basis:

- Be willing to work with a team, knowing that you are not the only one involved, as well as be willing to listen to and follow the leader.
- Communication is critical to any team, but not all communication is good. All talk should be helpful and encouraging to the body (Ephesians 4:29, Hebrews 10:25).
- Attending and being on time to practice on Thursday at 6:30, and Sunday morning at 7:00 or 8:00, depending on which campus you're involved in. If you cannot attend one of these practices you **must** let Pastor Mike know.
- All those involved should wear modest clothing, women being especially careful with dresses or skirts, as you are on a stage.
- Regular involvement and attendance to Grace Church whether you are involved in the music team that week or not.
- If you cannot be involved during one of your assigned weeks, you must let Pastor Mike know at least a month in advance **AND** find someone else to replace or switch with you.

By filling out an application you are agreeing to abide by these expectations and be willing to discuss any problems that arise with Pastor Mike.
